Introduction

The intent of this requirement is to broaden the student's exposure to the major areas of mechanical engineering and other related fields. Students are encouraged to attend as many seminars as possible and area also encouraged to look outside the department at other seminars to broaden the student's exposure.

Seminar Requirement

- **All** full-time ME graduate students are required to register for ME 5944 during Fall 2009 for which they are a full-time student and reside on campus.
- Off-campus students who have classes on M-W-F 4pm – 5pm are excused and do not have to register.
- A grade of Pass or Fail will assigned based on attendance and participation.
- The seminars do not count towards graduation requirements.
- Each student shall attend a minimum of **7** seminars per semester.
- A minimum of **5** seminars must be the regularly scheduled “ME Seminar Series”. Other technical seminars offered by other departments, centers, etc can be used to satisfy the remaining seminar requirements. Please email Brandy McCoy if you attend any non-ME seminars.
- Students will sign an attendance sheet at the ME Seminars they attend. Attendance for other technical seminars will be on the honor system.
