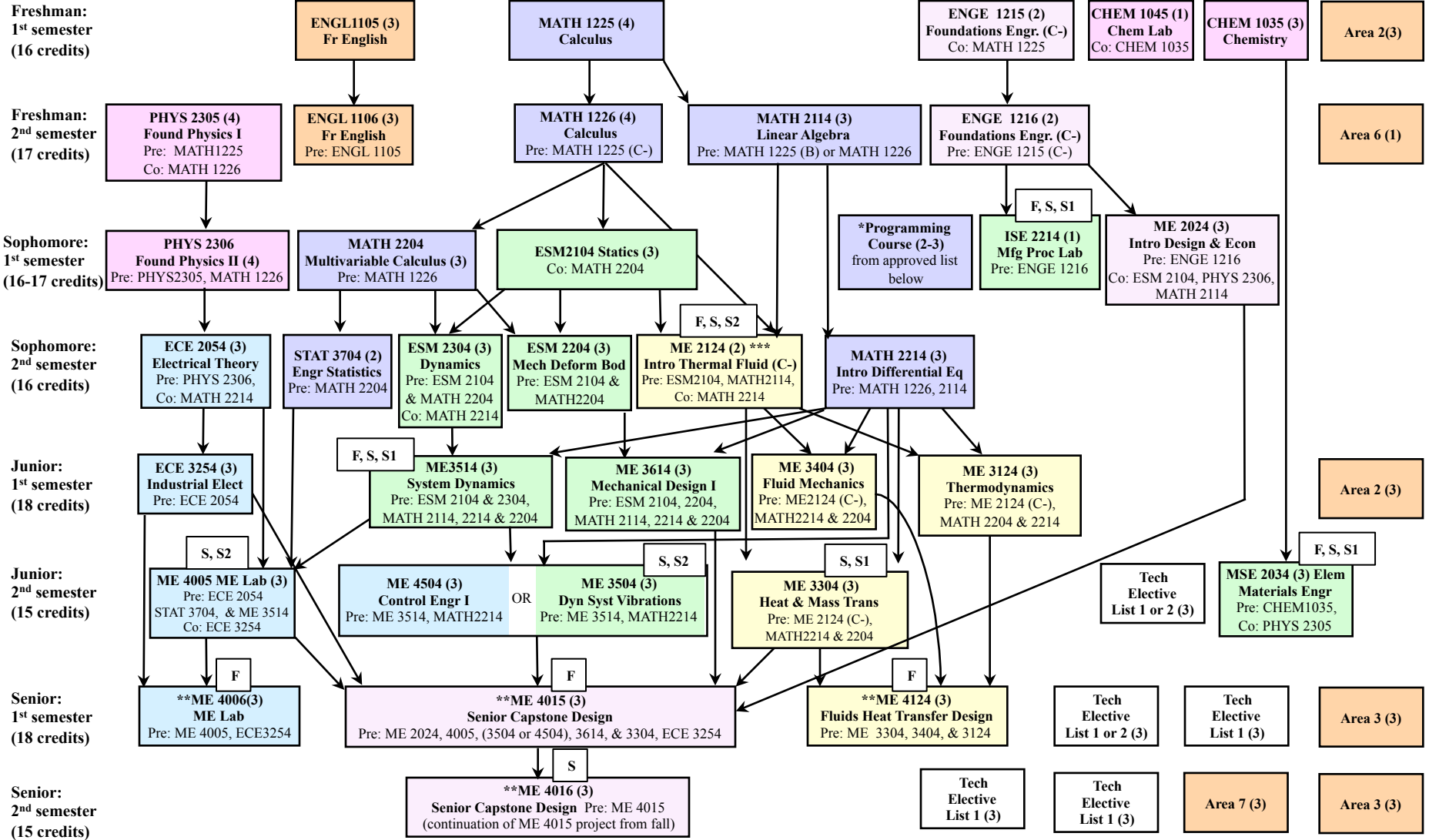

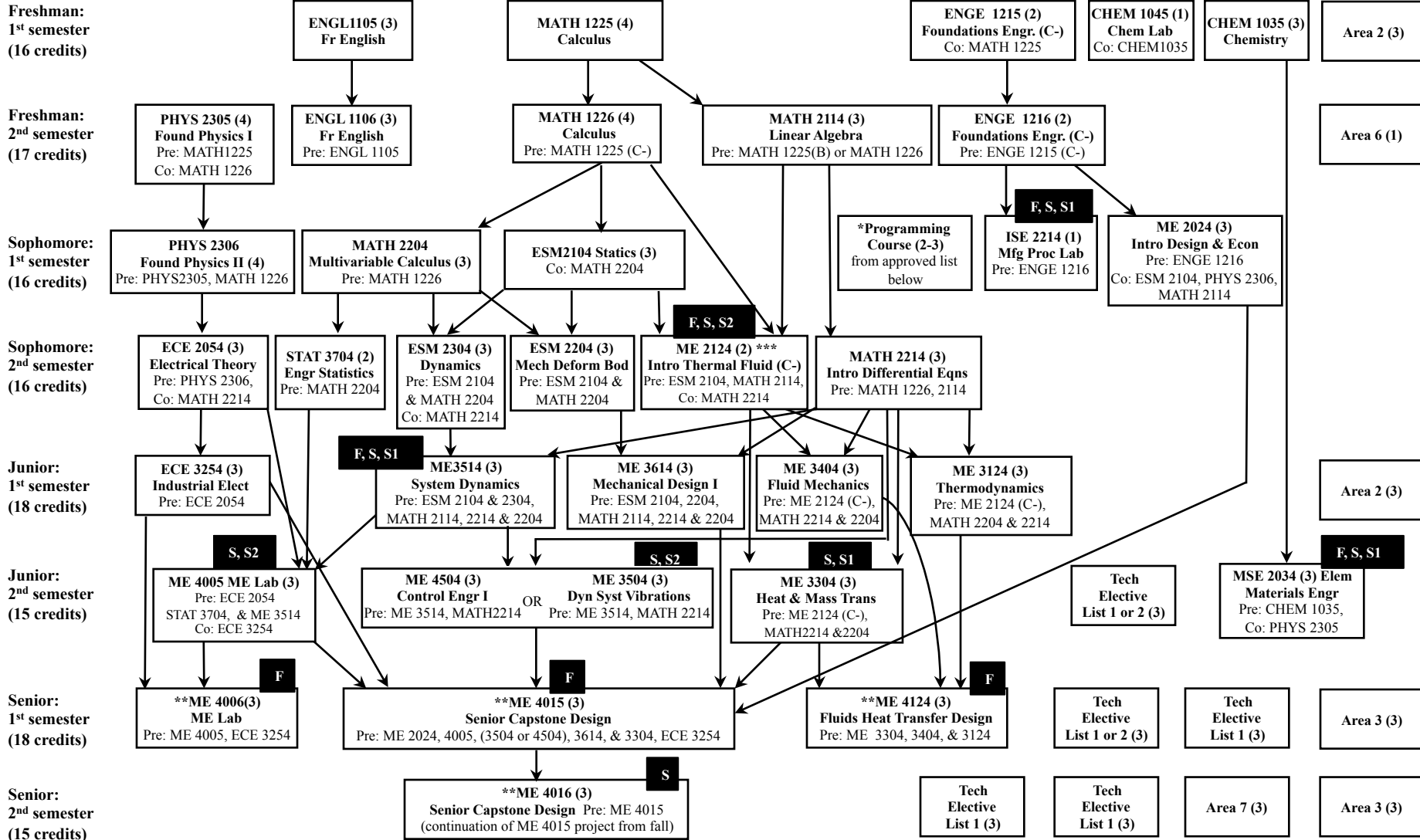

-By 90 attempted required credits completion of ME4006, ME4015, & ME4124
